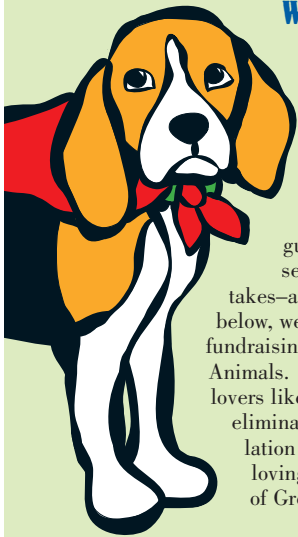


WHY WALK?



Walking will help save lives.

We can't continue to help the homeless animals of Miami-Dade County and offer important services to our community without your support. The Humane Society of Greater Miami receives no funding from any other Humane Society or animal welfare organization. To continue to guarantee every pet in our care a second chance—no matter how long it takes—and offer the programs described below, we rely solely on donations, grants and fundraising events like the Walk for the Animals. With the support of kind animal lovers like you, we will realize our mission to eliminate cruelty, neglect and pet overpopulation and create a more kind, just and loving community for the pets and people of Greater Miami.

Your Support Helps us Provide:

Adoption Services

The Humane Society of Greater Miami provides shelter and adoption services for up to 400 cats and dogs every day. All adopted pets go home spayed or neutered, with their up-to-date vaccinations, a microchip for permanent identification and dogs receive county tags and registration.

Humane Education

Last year HSGM reached over 8,000 K-12 Miami-Dade public school children with lessons about the importance of kindness, responsibility and commitment to companion animals and each other.

Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Program

It is estimated that for every person born in Miami-Dade County, there are approximately 45 cats and 15 dogs also born. In order to fight pet overpopulation, HSGM provides low-cost spay/neuter services to the public and all animals adopted from the Society go home spayed or neutered.

Safe Families, Safe Pets

HSGM aids domestic abuse victims by taking in their pets and caring for them at no cost, until the family is in a safe place.

Pet Assisted Therapy

The power of a soft paw is proven every day as HSGM's Visiting Pet Partners volunteers take their pets to visit the residents of nursing care facilities throughout Miami.

Obedience Counts!

- Dogs must be at least six months old, leashed, licensed and vaccinated for rabies. (Come to the Society's low-cost clinics for vaccinations.)
- Please do not bring females in season. (Ask about our low-cost spay/neuter services.)
- Please bring and use pooper scoopers.
- No roller blades, bicycles, or skateboards.
- Children 13 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult.
- Healthy dogs only; help us avoid problems with over-heating and exhaustion.
- Dogs only please, but signs or photos of your cat, bird, iguana or other companion animal are welcome.
