

Volunteer Job Description – Laundry Attendant

Focus of the Job: The primary responsibility of the Laundry Attendant Volunteer is to assist with the shelters laundry.

Reports to: The department staff member you are assisting that day and the Volunteer Coordinator

Requirements:

- Orientation
- Shelter Training

Tasks:

- Assisting with laundry
- Sorting towels, linens, pet beds, pet toys and other laundry items by material.
- Washing items with commercial laundry equipment following by proper washing protocols
- Unloading laundry from dryers
- Maintaining laundry area
- Discard any broken toys, ripped towels or beddings
- Dust/ wipe down all machines.
- Clean all filters and drains.
- Discard trash end of shift.
- Clean out all empty laundry bins and wipe down using proper disinfect

Physical Requirements:

- Must be able to stand for up to 3 hours
- Must be able to reach and bend

Work Environment:

Medium paced environment

Shift Rules:

Wristbands must be worn by volunteers at all times and must be visible to Humane Society staff

Dress Code:

This job follows regular dress code of denim jeans covering ankles, sneakers, and volunteer shirt. If you decide to bring a sweater or long-sleeved shirt, it must be worn under your volunteer shirt.
